Entries for the Citizen of Brockenhurst Award 2020 close on Saturday, January 16, 2021. Entries cannot be accepted after this date. After judging, the Awards will be announced (from a shortlist) at a presentation event, details to be decided under the social distancing rules (then) in place.

There are three categories and three awards (one in each category) will be made. Although one award specifically refers to COVID, this can apply to any entry:

Brockenhurst Neighbour or Friend of the Year – given for an exceptional friendly and neighbourly act to an individual or family. Examples could include an individual who has:

- helped in a crisis or emergency or helped with activities they can't do themselves;
- a care worker who has gone beyond the call of duty;
- a delivery person who's spotted something and reported it and stopped a calamity;
- or in any other way helped a friend and/or been a good neighbour.

Contribution to Brockenhurst Life – given for a wider exceptional contribution to the life or reputation of Brockenhurst. This may be an individual who is or has been:

- a team manager, coach, captain who's worked to promote their team and the village;
- someone who has contributed to a specific activity in the village such as Church life or a young persons' organisation to the betterment of the community;
- arranged or contributed to an environmental initiative which has improved the village;
- or in any other way made Brockenhurst a better place to live.

Citizen who helped in Brockenhurst through COVID – given to any person who performed a specific duty, act or undertaking through COVID. For example, a person who has:

- cooked, shopped or delivered meals to someone who was self-isolated;
- launched a quiz or other online event to help local people stay in touch;
- regularly checked on a vulnerable friend to ensure they were OK;
- contributed to a community service, such as local meals, to help those in difficulty;
- or in other ways has acted with kindness, generosity, or taken responsibility during COVID to make life better for someone else or the community.

Judging will include village representatives, and their decision will be final. Should a nomination not be successful this year, it may be re-submitted for subsequent events.

Trustees of the Brockenhurst Village Trust may submit a nomination, but are not eligible themselves to be proposed, nor are the judges, and any such entries will be ignored.

As well as the description, the number of entries for an individual (if more than one) will also be taken into consideration. Previous entrants and winners are eligible. You may only make one entry for each person you propose. However, you may enter different people in the three categories, each on a separate form.

Please be aware that this competition and its result will receive publicity. The winners will be announced and receive a presentation at an event to be held under the isolation rules at that time – this may be online or in Brockenhurst Village Hall, at a date to be decided.
